The P.E.T. Project of Middle Tennessee, a non-profit organization. was founded by Freddie Brown and members of the Blackman United Methodist Church. Since 2004, volunteers in the local workshop have built more than two hundred complete P.E.T. vehicles and have shipped them to disabled persons in developing countries around the world, including Namibia, Sierra Leone, Mexico and Honduras. Working with friends in Texas, we have helped to establish a workshop to build P.E.T.s in Mexico.

The P.E.T. Project of Middle Tennessee is an affiliate of P.E.T. International, a non-profit organization that is a special mission of the United Methodist Rural Fellowship. Founded in 1994 by Rev. Mel West, P.E.T. International and its affiliates around the world build these hand operated vehicles for persons who have lost the use of their legs through birth defects, injuries or illness. Since all the work is done by volunteers, all contributions to The P.E.T. Project go directly to the construction of the vehicles.
